## City of Selden City Council meeting minutes September 13, 2021

Bernie stated that he has been asked about the city snow plow. Leroy stated that it should not be sold.

Leroy will be mowing at the old landfill with the county mower.

The light in the kitchen of the Community Building needs to be replaced. It was decided to replace it with an LED light.

There being no further business, Steve motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:41 p.m. Dusty seconded, the motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
