

City of Selden
City Council meeting minutes
September 11, 2023

The Governing Body of the City of Selden met in regular session on September 11th, 2023 at the Selden City Office. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Mayor, Bernie Koerperich. Present were: Jacque Boultinghouse, Dusty Spresser, Steve Rogers, Danielle Schiltz, and Tammie Stevenson, Council Persons; and Jacqueline A. Neff, City Clerk.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited at this time.

Jacque motioned and Danielle seconded to close the hearing regarding the Revenue Neutral Rate. The motion carried

Danielle motioned and Steve seconded to adopt Resolution #72 regarding the Revenue Neutral Rate. The motioned carried.

Danielle motioned and Jacque seconded to accept the 2024 budget. The motion carried.

The council went over the minutes from the August 14th meeting. Tammy motioned and Steve seconded to approve the minutes as written. The motion carried.

Bernie stated that Hitchcock Inc. will be here tomorrow to install the generator. Bernie and Leroy will not be in town so Steve said he would be available if needed.

Danielle stated that she is still waiting on bids for the new fence.

Jackie stated that she had talked to Dan about the Community Building repairs. He stated to her that he still needs to replace the lights.

There was a speaker phone call with Leroy. He stated that the items that will be paid tonight are city supplies for the meters at Jerry Kaus' new apartments. The parts that he will need for the new line may take up to a year to get.

The council went over the monthly voucher list. Tammie motioned and Dusty seconded to approve the voucher list and warrants be drawn on the Treasury for the same. The motion carried.

Jacque motioned and Steve seconded to approve the applications for Gloria Goscha's Cereal Malt Beverage licenses. The motion carried.

Danielle stated that there are currently not any curb & gutter grants available to apply for. If one would become available an LMI survey would need to be done.

There was also discussion about Senior Citizens activities grant that would be incorporated with Hoxie.

There will be a meeting with the Sheridan County Community Foundation on the 25th of October at the Community Building.

There are some semis parking on the streets. We need to let Brandon know to patrol this and give tickets if it continues.

The citizens need to be reminded that their trash needs to be bagged and trash receptacles need to weigh less than 50 pounds.

There being no further business, Danielle motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:07 p.m. Dusty seconded, the motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
