

Now on this 28th day of September 2021, the Board of Commissioners, Sheridan County, Kansas met in regular session with Vice-Chairman Joe Bainter presiding. Others present were Buck Mader, Joe Pratt, County Attorney and County Clerk Heather Bracht. Guest was Carolyn Meyer and The Sheridan Sentinel.

Joe Bainter called the meeting to order at 8:00 am.

Those in attendance stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bracht asked about advertising in the Golden Plains 2022 Yearbook at a cost of \$75.00. This has been done for the last several years. Joe Bainter made a motion to advertise again, seconded by Mader. Carried 2-0.

Pratt distributed a rough draft of the Right-of-Way Mowing Agreement which was discussed briefly.
